

Capital Campaign Projects Update

Thanks to the ongoing fulfillments of campaign commitments, we are able to continue with our planned projects.

- The carpeted area around the Baptismal font that has been significantly affected by water damage, and the font itself will be restored and renovated. Plumbing leading to the font will be capped. The font will be moved to a temporary location until the spring when it will be situated in a permanent location.
- The carpeted areas in the rear of the church and in front will be restored to their original design with pews and kneelers.
- The center aisle will be widened by about 18 inches on both sides in the first five pews. This will allow for freer movement with the distribution of Holy Communion as well as for weddings and funerals.
- The terrazzo floors in church and in the narthex (Great Hall), and the marble in the sanctuary will be cleaned down to the original stone and polished. The same is planned for St. Joseph's Hall.
- The lighting upgrades and rewiring should take place in early March enabling us to appreciate the restorations that are soon to begin.
- Once the church work is completed, we will embark of Phase Two of our plan to clean St. Joseph's Hall, renovate the existing restroom and add another, and fully renovate the kitchen.
- This spring and summer, we will begin and complete much needed pointing on the north and west sides of the rectory.
- We are making steady progress with organ repairs. The organ builder who we have been working with is taking great care with gradual improvements and as he gets to know the instrument will be able to give us a plan for full restoration.

Thank you so much for your support of Queen of All Saints and our capital campaign. Please continue to make regular payments on your commitments so that we can make steady progress toward the fulfillment of our plan to improve our "quality of worship" and "quality of life" in QAS.
