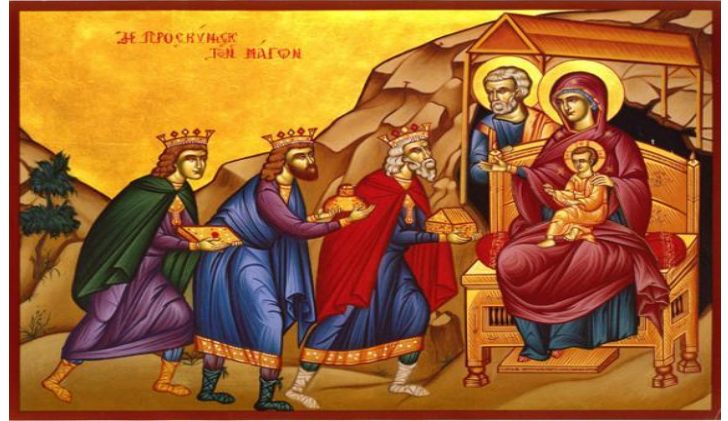

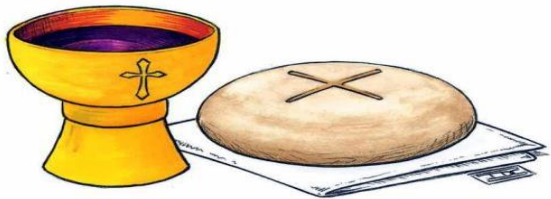


The Epiphany of the Lord
